Croydon TramLink

Tramlink began operation in May 2000. The system operates a fleet of 24 articulated low-floor trams running over three lines totaling 18 miles of track. There are 39 tram stops including Tamworth Road. Trams serve the center of Croydon and radiate out from there to Wimbledon, New Addington, Elmers End and Beckenham Junction. Interchange is possible with National Rail and the London Underground at certain points.
